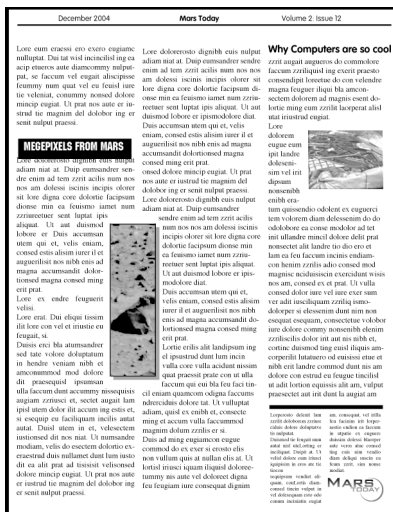

Project #6 – InDesign Newsletter – 30 pts

Adobe InDesign is a page layout program used for bringing together raster images, vector artwork, and copy (text). Page layout programs aren't generally used to create content, rather they assemble content that was created in other applications. For this project we will be creating a 2-page newsletter in InDesign. The newsletter will contain 3 articles and a bibliography; choose 3 topics from the list on the following page and research them for your articles. You are primarily the editor of this newsletter so you needn't come up with original content for all 3 articles. One article you will research and write yourself (think of it as a really short report). The other two can be reprinted from other sources with appropriate documentation (Though you are not writing these articles you may need to edit them for length and continuity.)



WARNING: InDesign does not “embed” image data into its documents like you may have done in Illustrator. For this reason it is imperative that you keep all of your files together and well organized!

Specifications:

- Research and thumbnail!!!
- The title must be created in Illustrator
- Any other vector art must be created in Illustrator
- Raster images may be captured with a digital camera, scanned, or downloaded from the Internet (all must be print resolution!)
- You MUST cite the source of any downloaded images or quoted text
- Any raster image editing must be done in Photoshop
- The newsletter will contain at least 3 articles
- The newsletter will contain at least 4 images (including at least one vector illustration)
- The text should wrap around at least one image on each page
- Final print is in black & white
- Final print should be double-sided
- Package your project when you are completely finished with it
